INTRODUCTION: Harriet Gill founded the Friends of San Diego Architecture in 1985 at the age of 71 with the intention of bringing together design professionals and lay people for mutual education, enlightenment, and discussion about architecture and the built environment. She continued to lead the organization and moderate the meetings until she was 93 years old. Her education and career in clinical social work, with her passionate feminism and her wide-ranging interests in philosophy, religion and the arts informed her many contributions to the community. She passed away on August 8, 2008 at the age of 94.

PURPOSE OF AWARD: To keep alive the memory of Harriet Gill by annually rewarding an architecture or related design student who demonstrates creative and/or innovative design ability towards positive social impact. Current Annual Award: \$1,000

APPLICANT: Any student enrolled in the study of architecture or a related design discipline within San Diego County, but not yet employed in a full-time career in his/her chosen profession.

SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

- 1) Completed Application Form.
- 2) Submission of a student-designed project, whether fully completed or a work in progress.
- 3) Submissions shall be in graphic form along with a written narrative of the proposed project (500 words max).
- 4) All submitted projects shall be in a single PDF electronic file, size of graphics and size of complete graphics file as selected by the applicant.
